

## Lempster Rescue June Summary

**Call Log:** The Rescue Squad has been dispatched to 14 calls since the beginning of May. Calls have ranged from breathing difficulties, car accidents, and strokes to a trench rescue.

- 6 calls in Lempster
- 5 calls mutual aid to Unity
- 2 calls mutual aid to Marlow
- 1 call mutual aid to Acworth

**Trainings:** Last Rescue training we had we reviewed the state protocols for heat emergencies with the warmer months upon us. We discussed our standard practices as EMT's and reviewed different scenarios and how to treat the patient.

**Spending:** This past month I spend \$141.63 on supplies for the rescue truck. These include the purchase of Nasal and Oral airway kits, Nitrile gloves and disinfectant wipes. I will be replacing expired epinephrine this month along with restocking a few other necessities. This purchase has not been made because of the cost of the drug. I am currently looking into alternative companies which could be cheaper.

**News:** We are in the beginning stages of working with the EHS coordinator of the wind farm on doing a joint training on how to treat certain injuries that can occur while working on the wind farm.
