

Lempster Rescue August Summary

Call Log: The Rescue Squad has been dispatched to 10 calls since the beginning of September. Calls have ranged from breathing difficulties, lift assists to 2 separate significant leg injuries.

- 10 calls in Lempster

Trainings: September meeting was postponed so that the rescue crew could take part in a joint training at the wind farm however there were last minute issues which caused the training to be postponed until a later date.

Spending: This month I purchased the Epi and Epi Jr. I also had to resupply the rescue with a number of different sized bandages and trauma dressings along with the purchase of another case of gloves. We also thought that our traction split was lost following one of our leg injury calls so I purchased a new collapsible traction split to replace the old one. Two days after the purchase, it was randomly found. The new traction splint will be put into service on our off-road 6x6 unit.

News: In the upcoming month we will have the opportunity to attend a training called "Surviving the Insult" in Newport and we are scheduled to take part in a joined MCI training at the Fall Mountain Regional High school with other departments that are associated with CRAFCA.
