Request for Proposals
Cemetery Tree Removal

The Lempster Cemetery Trustees are seeking proposals for the removal of a tree in the East Lempster Cemetery at the corner of Route 10 and the 2nd NH Turnpike. The tree is next to the brick shed, visible from the 2nd NH Turnpike and marked by orange tape. All proposals must be received at the Town Office in hand or by mail at PO Box 33, Lempster, NH 03605 by Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at 5:00 PM. Please mark the envelope "Tree Removal."

Bidders are encouraged to include in their proposal the specific manner in which they propose to complete the work, and the history of their business, relevant experience and references. The Bidder, in submitting a proposal, commits to the following:

- Obtain any required permits.
- Remove the tree in the manner specified in the proposal.
- Supply all materials.
- Maintain a clean, safe and orderly worksite.
- Be responsible for the removal of all tree limbs and debris.
- Complete work by August 31, 2017.
- Provide proof of proper insurance and limits.
- W9 required.
- Agree to and comply with all terms and conditions specified below.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

It is expressly understood that Bidder is an Independent Contractor and not the agent, partner, or employee of the Town. By responding to this inquiry Bidder certifies that it is an Independent Contractor and is solely responsible for acts and omissions, control and direction of its employees or workers. Bidder and Bidder's workers are not employees of the Town and are not entitled to tax withholding, Workers' Compensation, unemployment compensation, or any employee benefits, statutory or otherwise.

Any personal injury to Bidder or third parties or any property damage incurred in the course of the performance of the services shall be the responsibility of the Bidder. Bidder agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Town for any injuries or damage from the performance of the contract by Bidder. In the event of damage to any gravestones, Bidder shall be responsible for the full cost of restoration of any damaged stones

Proposals and price quotations are subject to public disclosure after a proposal is selected. Any responses, materials, correspondence, or documents provided to the Town or Trustees are subject to the State of New Hampshire Right-To-Know Law, RSA 91-A, and may be released to third parties in compliance with that Law.

The Cemetery Trustees reserve the right to solicit any additional information from Bidders that it deems pertinent to determine which Bidder best meets the needs of the Town. The Trustees also reserves the right to investigate any and all Bidders to determine the Bidder's ability to perform services under the RFP.

REJECTION/AWARD OF PROPOSALS: The Trustees reserve the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to negotiate with any or all Bidders, and to waive any informalities in the Request for Proposals process, and to enter into an agreement with the Bidder whom the Trustees in their sole discretion determine is in the best interest of the Town even though the Bidder may not submit the lowest bid or proposal. Bidders shall be responsible for any and all expenses that they may incur in preparing their proposals.

Payment schedule to be agreed upon with the Trustees before start date. Final payment will be made upon completion and the satisfaction of the Trustees.
