The Friends of the Lempster Meeting House, a 501(c)(3) organization, was formed to assist the Town of Lempster in raising funds solely for the conservation, restoration, and rehabilitation of the Lempster Meeting House, a landmark building constructed in 1794, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and is one of only five meeting houses of its kind remaining in New Hampshire. The goal is to make the Lempster Meeting House a resource for the entire community, to preserve it as a landmark for the State of New Hampshire, and to set up a stewardship program to oversee its continued maintenance and repair in the future.
