Approved Minutes September 6, 2017

The meeting was called to order by chair, Jim Beard at 6:11 pm.

We started the meeting by reviewing the proposed trail system on the Long Pond Town Forest, with Swift. The costs are estimated to be around \$8000. We will seek partial grant money for this project, possibly a Quabbin to Cardigan grant.

The trail system will be marked in the spring of 2018, (half of payment due at that time, with a balance at completion) in conjunction with the proposed timber sale on this property. Due to the topography a summer timber harvest would be best, so we will look to 2018 for this to happen.

Minutes: The minutes of the August 9, 2017 meeting were approved with a motion by Jim and second by Andria. All were in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Balance in the Lake Sunapee account was \$14,039.68, as of 7-31-17. A motion was made by Sue, second by Jim to approve the treasurer's report. All were in favor.
