Lempster Conservation Commission Approved Minutes February 7, 2019

In southwestern NH there are four towns (www.nhltc.org) that are not covered by a land trust; Lempster, Acworth, Langdon and Washington. The Conservancy currently has over 200 protected properties. They currently do not cover our area, but it is in the works. We appreciated her meeting with us.
