Chairman Tirrell called the Public Hearing to order at 8:45 AM.

Chairman Tirrell read the Notice of Public Hearing to receive public input on the acceptance and expenditure of a donation for \$14,555.87 for the purchase of a cardiac monitor. The notice was posted at the Town office, website and library on December 4, 2020 and in the Eagle Times on December 9, 2020.

Chairman Tirrell said that the Fire Fighter Association had donated \$14,555.87 toward the purchase of a cardiac monitor and the balance of \$6,304.13 would come from the Rescue Equipment Capital Reserve, previously established. He asked if there was any public input. Mr. Moore and Mr. Clark expressed their appreciation to the residents for their donations.

Selectman Thurber made a motion to accept and expend the donation of \$14,555.87 for the purchase of a cardiac monitor with the balance of \$6,304.13 coming from the Rescue Equipment Capital Reserve. Selectman Grenier seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Selectman Grenier made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing at 8:53 AM. Selectman Thurber seconded the motion. All were in favor.
