Fire and Rescue Department Report

Chief Thomas submitted a written report (see attached). Town office will order 6 "No Parking Fire Lane" signs for the dry hydrant areas. The ladder truck is having corrosion issues addressed and upgrading the lighting.

Chairman Tirrell mentioned that the three computers previously purchased five years ago under EMPG are not working. They have gone out for evaluation. NH HSES has offered to assist in filing for an EMPG grant to procure new computers. This is a 50/50 grant. There is also EMPG funds available to upgrade the base radio to a dual head base radio. The Board supported looking into pricing.
