This lot is located in the burial ground known as **East Lempster Cemetery**, located in the **Town of Lempster** according to the plat of the said cemetery, duly filed in the office of the Town Clerk.

The Lot Holder has the right to designate the person or persons who may be interred in said lot and to change that designation at any time in the future. The initial designation, if any, is indicated on the Cemetery Lot Purchase Agreement below. If there is no designation, then by default, these persons include the Lot Holder, the Lot Holder's mate at the time of death, and the Lot Holder's children, subject to the capacity of the lot and the regulations of the cemetery. The rights of the Lot Holder may be exercised by their heirs, executors, administrators, assigns or other duly authorized legal representative

If the right to inter has not been exercised, the Lot Holder may relinquish the right to the Town, and the original price stated below shall be refunded to the Lot Holder. No other transfer or sale of the above described right shall be allowed.

The right to inter is subject to specific regulations regarding lot capacity, decorations, planting of trees and shrubbery, placing of markers and monuments, and such other regulations as adopted by the Town.

This purchase contract is subject to Forfeiture Procedures (RSA 289:18).
