WANTED Highway/Transfer Station Supervisor

The Town of Lempster is seeking applicants for a Highway/Transfer Station Supervisor. This is a management position reporting to the Lempster Board of Selectmen. Duties may include, but are not limited to the operation, supervision and management of the highway and transfer station departments, including direct supervision of the employees. Successful candidate will be an active participant in all departmental duties with an emphasis on employee engagement, growth and supervision. This is a full time position, 40 hours per week with on-call evenings, weekends and holidays as needed. **A CDL-A or B is required preferably with a minimum of 2 years' experience.**

We desire comprehensive technical and practical knowledge of the materials, methods, and techniques related to highway projects, snow/ice removal, other highway/road issues and Transfer Station operations. Must become certified as a NH Solid Waste Facility Operator.

Work is performed in both office and field settings. Considerable outdoor work is required in the management and supervision of projects. Work is performed in a variety of environmental conditions, including outside weather conditions of heat, cold, precipitation, etc. There is exposure to normal construction hazards in addition to the everyday risks or discomforts that require normal safety precautions.

Must be within a reasonable response time of no more than 30 minutes to the Town of Lempster.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Knowledge of operating and servicing heavy-duty trucks/equipment.
- Knowledge of regulations, work hazards, safety practices and traffic laws relating to highway maintenance duties.
- Ability to perform frequent strenuous physical effort under all weather conditions, to detect issues with heavy equipment operations and maintenance, to understand and follow oral and written instructions, to complete reports and maintenance records as required.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with fellow employees.
